

Chinese Christian Fellowship at Clemson (CCFC)

Directions to CCFC from Greenville: Coming from US 123 into the city Clemson, you will soon see a Comfort Inn and an ACE store on your right at the stoplight. Follow US 123 to the second stoplight and turn left onto College Ave. (SC 133). Go pass Bank of America on your right and proceed to the First Baptist Church (FBC) parking garage to your right at the second traffic lights.

Directions to CCFC from Atlanta: Take I-85 north to exit 14 (Pendleton/Clemson exit, route 187) in South Carolina. Proceed north on SC 187 toward Pendleton and Clemson until it meets US 76. Turn left onto US 76, proceed toward Clemson and exit onto US 123 (turn left on 123 at the stoplight, an ACE store across the street). Follow US 123 to the second stoplight and turn left onto College Ave. (SC 133). Go pass Bank of America on your right and proceed to the First Baptist Church (FBC) parking garage to your right at the second traffic lights.

Park either in the parking garage (free) or the parking lot by the church building (space is limited) and go to the new brick building next to the parking garage. (Since the parking is tight on Sunday, it is suggested that you come either around 10:30am before Sunday school or 11:15am in order to find a parking close to the building.) We **meet in the parlor** (the room across the hallway from the church day-care office) on the first floor of the old education wing.
